Come to Me!

'Come to Me!' This is what the Lord told the youth meeting together in Bethlehem, together with CCR leaders from around the world, for the ICCRS Prophetic Consultation in November 2013.

Jesus is waiting for the youth of the world.

During a homily in Bethlehem, Archbishop Emeritus Barry J Hickey said, "our call is to have an intimate relationship with Jesus and to bring the youth of the world to Jesus, so they can also have an intimate relationship with Him".

That's what this invitation is all about!

Who?

All the youth!

The invitation is for all youth who are identified with the charismatic experience in the various charismatic realities and expressions: individuals, groups, communities, schools of evangelisation, television nets, associations, religious institutes, seminaries, ecclesial movements.

Young people call us to renewed and expansive hope, for they represent new directions for humanity and open us up to the future, lest we cling to a nostalgia for structures and customs which are no longer life-giving in today's world.

Why?

To be one heart and one mind in the Holy Spirit!

For two reasons:

1. To be united as youth in the CCR in the presence of the Lord – without travelling or registration fee!
2. To pray for all the young people in the world, that they will come to meet Jesus and be baptised in the Holy Spirit.

'Jesus offers us the possibility of a fruitful life, a life of happiness; he also offers us a future with him, an endless future, in eternal life.

That is what Jesus offers us. But he asks us to pay admission, and the cost of admission is that we train ourselves "to get in shape", so that we can face every situation in life undaunted, bearing witness to our faith, by talking with him in prayer.'
