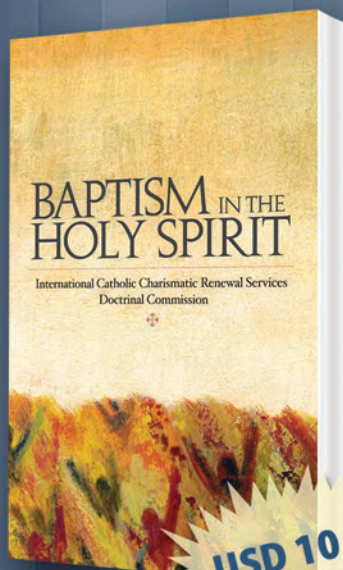
Mission

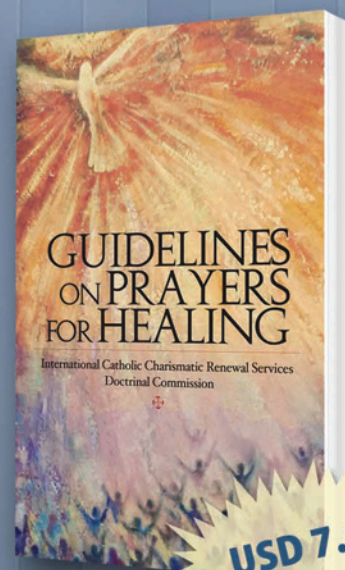

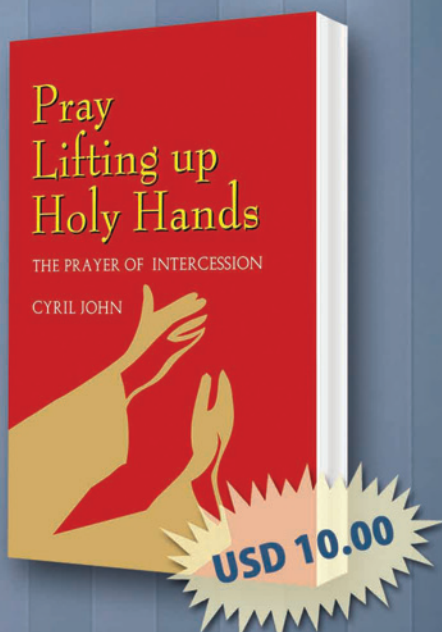

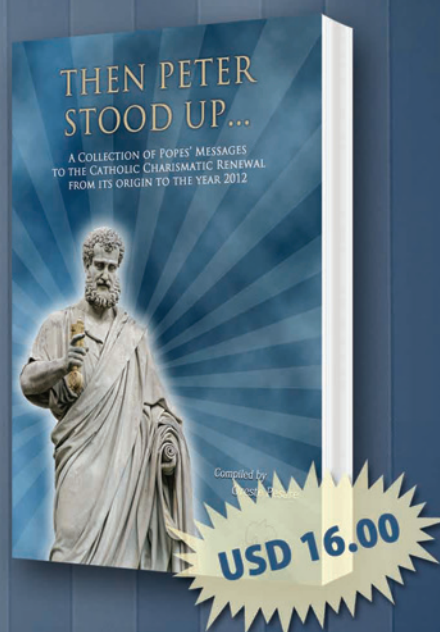
